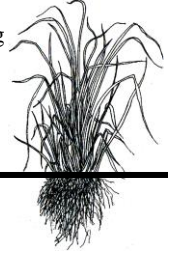

The 2016 Pennsylvania Hay Show was held at Ag Progress Days and sponsored by the Pennsylvania Forage and Grassland Council. There was good participation this year, with several classes having over 10 entries. Our largest classes were Class 7 with 28 entries and Class 8 with 22 entries.

Hay is judged on both visual and chemical characteristics and 1st through 5th placings are awarded to each class with more than 5 entries. Premiums are awarded to 1st through 3rd placings in each class, and all participants receive quality analysis information for every sample entered.
