



AFGC Hay Evaluation Contest Rules and Information



The American Forage and Grassland Council has revamped their National Hay Contest from a submission-based competition to an evaluation competition to engage and education all conference attendees on hay practices.

There will be four (4) hay samples with a variety of ranges in quality. Each sample will be in a box labeled with a letter from A to D and displayed at the AFGC Annual Conference with evaluation entry forms.

Any conference attendee wishing to participate in the competition will be able to enter an entry form by first placing ranking each entry by 1st, 2nd, 3rd and 4th place using the letter noted on the box; secondly note the Relative Feed Value/Quality and thirdly note the Crude Protein.

Once the competition closes, the entries will be pulled and each entry reviewed for the correct place ranking. The entries with correct rankings will then be reviewed for correct Relative Feed Value/Quality. The entries with correct Relative Feed Value/Quality for each sample will then be reviewed for Crude Protein to find a winner. If more than one entry is correct in all categories then those entries will be placed in a hat and a winner and second place entry will be drawn.

The entry with the most correct information will receive a \$100 gift card and the second place will receive a \$50 gift card.
